

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PORTAL AND OF PROVISION OF SERVICES BY
ELECTRONIC MEANS**

Section I. General Provisions

1. The website "www.zmieniajnaplepsz.pl" www.zmieniajnaplepsz.pl, hereinafter referred to as the "Website", is maintained by the Leopold Kronenberg Citi Handlowy Foundation with its registered office in Warsaw, 00-067, ul. Traugutta 7/9 NIP (Tax ID No.) 525-15-69-384, REGON (Business Registry No.) 011931715, registered with the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, 12th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, KRS no. 0000052030, hereinafter referred to as the "Foundation".
2. The Foundation operates pursuant to the Charter and the provisions of the Polish law.
3. One of the statutory purposes of the Foundation is to act for public benefit in education, culture and arts, protection of cultural heritage, healthcare and welfare, philanthropy, activity supporting economic development, including development of entrepreneurship, promotion of ideas and education in the field of corporate social responsibility, promotion and organization of volunteering, including volunteering aimed at provision of sports activities.
4. These Terms and Conditions, hereinafter referred to as the "T&C", lay down:
 - The purpose and the rules of the #StandWithUkraine campaign, under which the Foundation has initiated a fundraiser to support humanitarian aid for the victims of the ongoing armed conflict in Ukraine. The funds raised will, among others, support the relief efforts managed by the organization SOS Wioski Dziecięce (Children's Villages), Rakiety Oncological Foundation and Father Boduen Children's Home in Warsaw.

Section II. Purpose of the Fundraiser

1. The #StandWithUkraine campaign was launched in cooperation with Citi volunteers (#CitiVolunteers). Under the campaign, the "Rakiety" Oncological Foundation will subsidize medical transport and the purchase of drugs for oncologically ill people from Ukraine. The funds may also be used to provide medical care and support to the patients once they have crossed the border.
2. The Father Boduen Children's Home no. 15 in Warsaw will provide in-kind support, that is, personal hygiene items and camp beds, among others, and will support humanitarian aid for children in the ongoing conflict in Ukraine.
3. Moreover, the donations will also go to the organization SOS Wioski Dziecięce (Children's Villages) in Poland, which brings children from Ukrainian care institutions to Poland. The funds raised will be used to arrange the transportation, food, accommodation, psychological and educational support, as well as treatment and drugs.

Section III. Online payment

1. The Website enables online payments to the Foundation in support of the #StandWithUkraine campaign.
2. Online payments are serviced by Blue Media, an online payments platform. Upon clicking an appropriate link on the Website, you will be redirected to Blue Media.
3. Any and all amounts must be in Polish zlotys (PLN).
4. An online payment can be made using:

Section IV. Processing of Personal Data

1. The Controller of your personal data is the Leopold Kronenberg Citi Handlowy Foundation with its registered office in Warsaw, at ul. Traugutta 7/9, 00-067 Warsaw (hereinafter the “Foundation”)
2. The Controller can be contacted via email, at the address: poczta@kronenberg.org.pl or by mail, at the address of the registered office.
3. The Foundation processes personal data such as your first and last name and email address for the purpose of:
 - a) handling your donation, including its confirmation – the legal basis for data processing is its necessity for the performance of a contract (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR);
 - b) maintaining statistics of donations – the legal basis for data processing is the legitimate interest pursued by the Controller consisting in facilitating the process of making donations (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR);
 - c) exercising and defending against claims – the legal basis for data processing is the legitimate interest pursued by the Controller consisting in defending its rights (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR).
4. Your personal data will be processed for a period necessary for the performance of the contract. In the remaining scope, your data will be processed until the legitimate interest of the Controller ceases or until an effective objection against processing of personal data is filed. The term of processing may each time be extended by the claim limitation period if processing of personal data is necessary for the Controller to seek possible claims or defend against such claims.
5. In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the right to:
 - a) access your personal data and their backup copies;
 - b) rectify your data if they are inaccurate;
 - c) erase your data or restrict their processing;
 - d) object to processing of your personal data;
 - e) data portability.
6. Your personal data such as your first and last name, email address and amount of the donation in connection with the donation made will be made available to the payment operators. The legal basis for making data available is the legitimate interest of the Controller, that is, correct settlement of the donation made.
7. You have the right to file a complaint with a supervisory authority. The supervisory authority in Poland is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (UODO).
8. Provision of personal data is voluntary, however it is necessary to conclude a donation contract.

Section 5. Final Provisions

1. These Terms and Conditions shall come into effect on 28 February 2022.
